## **No Stakes on Pavement**

Use sand buckets, bricks, cinder blocks, or pvc and concrete weights on the pavement.

Friday, October 4, from 12:00 PM to dark [We strongly encourage you to set up at least your tent and tables on Friday.]

Saturday, October 5, from 7:00AM to 9:00AM Please pull to the right and leave the left lane clear. Please drop your articles and move your vehicle within moments. Festival volunteers will help unload.
